INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

During the 2010-2011 Academic Year, Gamma Sigma Alpha Honor Society will grant at least two (2) scholarships of a minimum of \$1,000 each to initiated members. These scholarships have been established to assist Gamma Sigma Alpha qualified members pursuing graduate studies at an accredited institution. Candidates will be considered on the basis of merit. Scholarship recipients will be announced by June 11, 2010.

ELIGIBILITY: Any initiated member of Gamma Sigma Alpha with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or better. All applicants must have been initiated prior to their application submission. Selection will be based upon academic record, recommendations submitted, the applicant's statement, and campus and community activities. *All scholarship recipients MUST be from a chapter of Gamma Sigma Alpha.*

- ❖ Applications that are NOT typed will not be considered

SCHOLARSHIP STIPULATIONS

- ❖ Acceptance of the scholarship involves an obligation to begin and complete the year of study following the award of the scholarship. The recipient must be enrolled full-time and must be working towards completion of a degree.
- ❖ Any request by a recipient for an exception shall be directed to the National Gamma Sigma Alpha Headquarters
- ❖ A scholarship will only be awarded for educational purposes.

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE RECIPIENT

- Notify the National Office of Gamma Sigma Alpha promptly of the acceptance of the scholarship
- Upon registration, request the Registrar of the institution attended to send a written statement of enrollment, with seal embossed, to the National Gamma Sigma Alpha Headquarters. The scholarship funds will then be sent directly to the recipient's college or university.
