<u>Resources</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is community made aware of resources available to them, i.e. campus, HQ, umbrella groups? • Is there an expectation for community to hold workshops on career development? • Are there programs offered to community members on cultural enrichment? • Does community have study space? • Is there an expectation for community to hold scholastic development programs? • Does community consider academic calendars when planning events? • Are appropriate officers educated to handle academic issues? 		
<u>Faculty Advisors/Relations</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do chapters have faculty advisors? • Do those advisors have a job description including expectations? • Is there an expectation for chapters to hold faculty appreciation events? • Is there a community faculty appreciation program? • Does the community recognize outstanding faculty? • Does the community provide an opportunity for the community and faculty to interact? 		
<u>Community Culture</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is the community culture conducive to academic success? • Do community members understand where they spend their time? • Is academic performance discussed during recruitment? • Are community academic standards discussed during new member programs? • Do community members take advantages of academic services provided? • Are academic expectations set and communicated up front? • Do members respect academic policies and requirements? • Does the community advertise honor society deadlines?
